President Scalo introduced Cindy Harbison.

Cindy distributed outlines and talked about asking family members, friends, coworkers and business associates to support our charitable events. She encouraged them to ask everyone to support in some way. Announcements:

President Scalo talked about our Golf Outing and introduced Golf Chairperson Ron Jones. The Gold Outing is Sunday May 2, 2010. Registration starts at 10:00 a.m. We only have 5 weeks left to do this. Scott Hacker said he has gotten some responses already. Joe Barch will do a foursome and he has two tee signs and Mars Bank may do a Corporate Sponsorship.

President Scalo introduced guest speakers, Dave Flick and Brad Patten from Family Psychological. Brad distributed information. Dave spoke. They started at the jail in October Their group does counseling and case management. They work with D & A and probation. They meet one on one with individuals inside the jail. Each person has to be from Butler County and have a mental health issue. Their case management involves a service plan which includes education, housing, D & A medication needs and activity of daily living needs. The biggest challenge is getting them medical insurance. Within 15 days of release the insurance is usually approved.

Brad spoke about demographics. He has had 7 since December and none have gone back to jail yet. Most are in their early 20's to mid 40's, and have had life-long mental health conditions which have not been addressed. They also have drug issues. All treatments are combined to make a mental health plan. They connect with mobile D & A screening, half way houses and Greenbriar Treatment Center and other supports. The individuals are mandated to stay with the program for 1 year after release from jail.

The 50/50 was won by Ron Jones.

There being no other business, President Scalo adjourned the meeting at 8:12 a.m.
